



Graduate Assistantship (half) - Trombone

Starting Date: August 2024

Duties: May include: teaching applied lessons, coaching chamber ensembles,

assisting with Trombone Choir, Studio Class and group warmups, or other

duties as needed.

Compensation: Complete tuition waiver (in or out-of- state) of up to 6 credit hours per

semester (plus 3 credits in the summer) and a stipend of \$5,980 per year

for two years.

Qualifications: Completion of an undergraduate degree in music, experience in trombone

instruction, excellent performance skills, a minimum GPA of 3.0 and

acceptance into the Missouri State University Graduate College.

Preference will be given to students pursuing the Master of Music degree.

Pedagogy, Conducting, Music Education, and Composition.
